Since June of 2014 we have housed over 100 families equaling 500 individuals with the majority being very young children. In **comparison to Lincoln County's** population families with disabilities, LGBTQ+ and people of color are disproportionately experiencing or at risk of homelessness. Most families are already employed when coming into our program. Over 80% of our families are able to graduate into housing.






